



STAFF VETERINARIAN

Job Description

Class: Contract (Part-time)

Reports to: Shelter Manager

Purpose of the Position:

The veterinarian provides certain professional services to the animals WAIF is responsible for, and to programs of WAIF that require such professional services that only a licensed veterinarian can provide. This is a part-time contract position (one day per week with one Saturday per month for TNR program).

WAIF's Veterinarian is responsible for the following:

- Professional surgical services – Spay/Neuter and other surgeries as needed.
- Medical related services including rabies vaccines and consultation on animal health issues.

Duties: Surgical Services

- Provide spay/neuter surgeries for animals within shelter.
- Perform post-op checks and order medications to ensure complete surgery recovery.
- Be available for the feral/free-roaming cat spay/neuter program (TNR program called CATsNIP – one Saturday per month).

Duties: Medical Related Services

- Provision of vaccines including Rabies as needed.
- Microchipping of shelter animals as needed.
- Be available for consultation on health issues of shelter animals via text, email, and in-person.
- Be available for consultation for cleaning/sanitizing protocols within shelter as needed.
- Oversee handling and recording of controlled substances by veterinary technician.

Other Requirements:

- Maintain a current veterinary license in good standing with state of Washington.
- Maintain the DEA license for the surgery clinic (WAIF covers cost).
